



SESSION 15 Transatlantic Vision 2024 – CONCLUSIONS

Key points raised included:

- There is a growing sense of urgency and need for stronger transatlantic cooperation between the EU and US in the face of growing threats and challenges from authoritarian regimes like China and Russia.
- Deeper economic integration through initiatives like a barrier-free transatlantic market over the next 10 years will help boost economic strength.
- Building cohesion and addressing differences in how the EU and US economies/business environments function is highlighted as critical for successful cooperation.
- Engaging legislatures and the public more, not just the executive branches, is recommended to build broader support.
- Multilateral outreach and bridge-building to countries that have become alienated is proposed as part of the mission over the next 5-10 years.
- There is optimism about the transatlantic framework like the Trade & Technology Council (TTC) could be built on to cover broader geopolitical and economic issues between the EU and US.

The TPN Team and the EP Library were commended for their support in ensuring the event's success.
