EU US PARTNERSHIP: VISION 2030 AND BEYOND

The deepening and broadening of the transatlantic relationship is an organic process. Since the creation of the Transatlantic Policy Network in 1992, TPN has worked with members of the business community, the European Parliament, US Congress and civil society to strengthen the US-EU partnership to better deal cooperatively with shared economic and strategic challenges.

To chart a roadmap toward a strengthened EU-US relationship, TPN launched Transatlantic Vision 2030 in July 2019. Bringing together insights from workshops, expert papers, and conversations with business leaders, policymakers, academics, and civil society, TPN has developed a series of recommendations on defense and geostrategy, economy and trade, digital transformation, climate and deepening engagement by political leaders, business leaders and civil society.

The product of those consultations--Vision 2030--will be released at TPN's annual Transatlantic Week 2025, in Washington DC July 21-23, 2025.

But Vision 2030 is an ongoing endeavor. We will continue our consultations with transatlantic stakeholders, adapting and elaborating our recommendations as conditions change, and new challenges emerge. Your input--at Transatlantic Week--and in the months and years ahead will be invaluable and most welcome.
